Announcement: Educator, Author Lisa Noel Babbage Enters 7th District Race as “Pro God, Pro America, Pro Life” Candidate

Duluth, Georgia -- While serving as the State Representative of Virginia Women for Trump, and the Gwinnett county co-chair of Georgia Women For Trump, Lisa Noel Babbage announces her candidacy this weekend at the Third Annual Trump Birthday Bash, Sunday, June 23rd, at the Trump International Hotel in Washington, DC.

Babbage has already garnered endorsements from the National Black Pro Life Union and Babies Lives Matter as a Pro Life candidate. Her efforts in the district have been punctuated by her participation as a member of the Executive Board of the Gwinnett County Republican Party as well as a member of the State Committee of the Georgia GOP. In 2018, she founded a civic organization, Women in Action, to be a surrogate between small businesses in Georgia and federal legislative efforts aimed at strengthening the economy of marginalized communities. She vows to keep the open seat being vacated by Congressman Rob Woodall in the “Republican camp.” She further pledges to contribute a significant portion of her legislative salary back to small businesses and community programs in the seventh district.

Lisa Noel Babbage is a veteran teacher in the DeKalb County Public School System as well as an adjunct Professor at Southeastern University. She is running for the 7th District to ensure that the conservative principles Georgians believe in are defended in Congress. She has a Master’s in Education from Mercer University and a Doctorate in Public Service from Capella University, ABD. She lives in Duluth with her family.
